Editors' Tip: The Progressive Revolution: Modern Art for a New India. Formed just months after the 1947 Partition of India and during tremendous violence and protest, the Progressive Artists Group (PAG) included artists seeking a break with their country's past and its cultural constraints.

## **When modern masters met - mumbai guide**

The Progressive Artists Group was a group of artists working in India in the mid-20th century. Based in Bombay (now Mumbai), the group, which included artists such as FN Souza, MF Husain, KH Ara, SK Bakre, and SH Raza, practiced an eclectic set of styles which drew from Indian folk tradition as well as from Western Modernist practices.

### **The Progressive Artists' Group was**

Sayed Haider Raza was born in Madhya Pradesh and studied at the Nagpur School of Art followed by Sir J. J. School of Art, Mumbai. He was a founding member of the Progressive Artists' Group. In 1950, he left for France on a French government scholarship to study painting at the Ecole nationale supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris.

### **Mumbai/Bombay: Modern Indian Artists- S. K. Bakre**

Often, the Progressive Artists Group set up in Mumbai during the late 1940s has been singled out as a

demarcating line but it is significant that even some of the painters of this group developed a greater maturity in their work during the early 50s, like, Gade, Souza, Husain, Raza, Ara and Bakre (the latter in sculpture).

He was part of the managing committee of the Bombay Art Society and served on the selection and judging committee of the Lalit Kala Akademi. ### **Firebrands Who Forged a New Art for a New India - The New ...**

In 1947, artists F N Souza, M F Husain, S H Raza, H A Gade, K H Ara and S K Bakre (sculptor) came together to form the Progressive Artists Group in Bombay. While they started out as a collective, some of the artists of this group developed a greater maturity in their work individually after 1951 when the group disintegrated and Souza, Raza and Ara went their separate ways.

### **Progressive Artists Group of Bombay: An Overview**

The Progressive Artists' Group formed within the fraught political and cultural climate that followed India's independence from British rule in 1947. As the

nation grappled with its new borders and newly established democracy, this modern group of artists sought to distance themselves from the nationalist Bengal School of Art by embracing a more international perspective.

### **#MumbaiMirrored: Making of the Bombay progressives**

Sadanand Bakre joined the J. J. School of Art in 1939, and won several awards for the next five years in the annual Bombay Art Society exhibitions. He was one of the founder members of the Progressive Artists' Group in 1948. In the following year, at the exhibition of the Bombay Art Society, his entry was awarded the Silver Medal for the best sculpture.
