Arabic Verb Conjugation. In Arabic, you can type in base verb forms such as “مَلَّكَتَ”, “رَفَّأَسَ”, “بَرَّشَ” ... but also conjugated forms (“بَرَّشَيْ”, “أَوْرَفَّأَسَ”, “نَوْمُ مَلَّكَتَ”). The conjugator recognizes Latin alphabet transliteration instead of Arabic characters (“shariba”, “saafara”, “takallama”).

When annotating Arabic verb forms, the convention in the Quranic Arabic Corpus is to use Roman numerals, e.g. IX denotes a form nine verb or noun.

Arabic verbs are noted for an unusual system of derivation. From any particular root various verb stems may be formed. Western scholars usually refer to these derivations as “form I”, “form II”, ... up through “form XV,” though these designations are not used indigenously, where they are referred to by derivations from the root ف ل ج (f-l-j).

## The Arabic Verb Form And

Form VIII verbs are characterized by a prefix of ا (the hamza is elidable, just as in Form VII) and a ت infixed between the first and second radicals. A sukun is then placed over the first radical. For example, فَشَتْكَ ا (‘‘to discover’’) is a Form VIII verb. Often the meaning of Form VIII verbs is reflexive.
